

Getting your Learning Disability Annual Health Check

	<p>Anybody with a learning disability age 14+ on the GP Learning Disability Register can have a Learning Disability Annual Health Check.</p>
	<p>Learning Disability Annual Health Checks are important as they help you to stay well.</p>
	<p>Your GP Practice will invite you for your Learning Disability Annual Health Check every year.</p>

	<p>Some people will need reasonable adjustments to help them have a good Learning Disability Annual Health Check. Remember to tell your GP Practice if you need reasonable adjustments.</p>

	<p>Before your Learning Disability Annual Health Check you might be asked to fill out an easy read questionnaire to help the Doctor or Nurse get some more information about you.</p>
